[Cheers and applause]


Kelly: You are going to meet my new cohost. He or she is ready to start his or her new job and would you like to meet him or her?

Ryan: I heard somebody say that he is much shorter in person. And I was fine with that. You know the truth.


Kelly: That's right. We have a big show today! Chris pratt is here! Bigger than this?

Kelly: That is robbie all the way from new york city!





So I stayed in the moment, and they kept on going, and then they yelled cut, and everybody rushed over, and I was like, there is a bird flying around my head all day.


Ryan: Have you thought about romantic comedies?

[Cheers and applause]


It is a leaning tower pyramid.


Ryan: All right!

Kelly: On tomorrow's show kurt russell is here.




